SUBMISSIONS AND SITTINGS:

Briefs were submitted by the parties and two (2) Sittings held December 2, 2024 and March 25, 2025.

REPORT TO THE TRIBUNAL:

At the 1st Sitting the parties indicated that they were amenable to engage in local level discussions. By letter dated June 16, 2025, the Aggrieved representative informed the Tribunal that the parties arrived at an agreement in principle and requested that the dates set for hearing to continue, be vacated and as a consequence, the Tribunal cancelled the scheduled sittings.
