The Government of Jamaica/Ministry of Labour & Social Security has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of implementing the Social Protection for Increased Resilience and Opportunity (SPIRO) Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for a for a System Integrator for the design, development, and operationalization of an Integrated Social Protection Information System¹.

Objective of the Consultancy:

To design, develop, and implement a Social Protection Information System for the Ministry of Labour & Social Security that serves as a centralized platform for all social assistance programmes/services. The system will enable a more efficient delivery of these programmes for both internal and external stakeholders.

Duration of the Consultancy:

The estimated implementation period is fifty-four (54) months as follows: Eighteen (18) months systems development and thirty-six (36) months of system warranty and implementation support services.

Selection Method:

Applicants will be shortlisted based on the submission's responsiveness to the eligibility criteria outlined in the Initial Selection Document (ISD). Applicants must meet the eligibility requirements specified in Table 1 – Qualification Criteria. Those whose applications are deemed
